Call to Prayer: August 29

We are calling for a day of prayer on Thursday, August 29. As we prepare for our Annual Diocesan Convention on September 20-21, we want to gather in prayer for our diocese. Parishes, schools, and ministries are asked to gather together on this day to pray for the healing and wholeness of our people, for the ministry and mission of our diocese, and for the upcoming Diocesan Convention. We also want to pray for those who have been nominated for positions in our diocese who will be on the ballot at the Convention. (The ballots will be released the following day on Friday, August 30.)

We encourage parish and regional gatherings to happen on this day. One opportunity is to join with us at St. John's Cathedral in Jacksonville at 6 p.m. for a Prayer Vigil. We will gather together to lift up our diocese as we prepare for our Diocesan Convention.

Audit Update

The Audit Committee is scheduled to meet this week to review the 2021 audit. We anticipate the 2021 audit to be complete in the coming weeks. Preliminary work has begun on the 2022 audit. All audits will be published as soon as they are complete. As of this writing, all audits to date are clean.

Other Financial Processes and Procedures

In an effort to have consistent policies and procedures, we continue to identify areas of priority. We are currently working on our final drafts for both the Sale and Purchase of Diocesan Property as well as applying for Nehemiah Funds. Both of these checklists will be available on the website as soon as they are finalized.

Bishop Updates

The question we are most often asked is in regards to the status of having a bishop in the Diocese of Florida.

First, with joy we have entered into an amended agreement with Bishop Scott Benhase. Bishop Benhase will increase his time in the Diocese of Florida from one-third of his professional time to half of his professional time beginning August 1. This will mean that he will be even more available to the Standing Committee and Diocesan Office staff, and more physically present in our diocese.

Secondly, since November 1, 2023, the Standing Committee has been working on steps to allow us to call for a bishop election. Much progress in this area has been made, which will be more fully articulated at our Annual Diocesan Convention.

In the meantime, please continue to keep the elected members of the Standing Committee in your prayers as we seek to make Christ known in our diocese and in our world.

Jesus, continue to guide us as brothers and sisters in Christ and as a diocese.
